**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF BIG BEAR AREA
REGIONAL WASTEWATER AGENCY IN SUPPORT OF
ORDINANCE NO. 3821 OF THE COUNTY OF SAN BERNARDINO,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA, RELATING TO REGULATIONS FOR GLARE,
OUTDOOR LIGHTING AND NIGHT SKY PROTECTION.**

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the Big Bear Area Regional Wastewater Agency (“Agency”) has reviewed Ordinance No. 3821 of the County of San Bernardino, State of California, relating to regulations for glare, outdoor lighting and night sky protection for the areas of Joshua Tree, Morongo Valley, Twentynine Palms, and Yucca Valley;

WHEREAS, the Agency supports the County's adoption of Ordinance No. 3821;

WHEREAS, the Agency urges the County of San Bernardino to include the Big Bear Valley among the areas protected by Ordinance No. 3821;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Board of the Big Bear Area Regional Wastewater Agency that the Agency supports Ordinance No. 3821 of the County of San Bernardino, State of California, relating to regulations for glare, outdoor lighting and night sky protection.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Governing Board of the Big Bear Area Regional Wastewater Agency that the Agency urges the County of San Bernardino to include the Big Bear

Valley among the areas protected by Ordinance No. 3821.
