**RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF BIG BEAR AREA
REGIONAL WASTEWATER AGENCY ADOPTING CONDITIONS FOR
THE ACCEPTANCE OF RESIDENTIAL SEPTIC AND HOLDING TANK
WASTE AND ADOPTING A RELATED PROCESSING FEE**

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the Big Bear Area Regional Wastewater Agency deems it necessary to provide a mechanism for the disposal of domestic septic tank and holding waste from area residents not served by local collection agencies;

WHEREAS, the Big Bear Area Regional Wastewater Agency is willing to accept such domestic septic tank and holding tank waste, provided the participating area residents comply with specific conditions;

WHEREAS, the Big Bear Area Regional Wastewater Agency will require persons seeking to participate in the program to complete an application;

WHEREAS, the Big Bear Area Regional Wastewater Agency incurs fees in processing such applications which should be recovered from those seeking to participate in the program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Board of the Big Bear Area Regional Wastewater Agency that the agency is willing to accept septic tank and holding tank waste from residences within the Big Bear Valley not served by local collection agencies for treatment in the Regional Treatment Facility, provided the conditions set forth in Exhibit "A," and "B" which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, are met.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Governing Board of the Big Bear Area Regional Wastewater Agency that persons submitting applications to participate in the Program shall pay a one-time non-refundable processing fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25).
