

RESOLUTION NO. R.03-2001 (Section 6.04)

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BIG BEAR AREA REGIONAL
WASTEWATER AGENCY AMENDING AND ADOPTING
LOCAL GUIDELINES FOR IMPLEMENTING THE
CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (PUB.
RESOURCES CODE § § 21000 ET SEQ)**

WHEREAS, the California Legislature has amended the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") (Pub. Resources Code §§ 21000 et seq.) and the State CEQA Guidelines (Cal. Code of Regs, tit. 14, §§15000 et seq.) and the California courts have interrupted specific provisions of CEQA;

WHEREAS, Section 21082 of CEQA requires all public agencies to adopt objectives, criteria and procedures for the evaluation of public and private projects undertaken or approved by such public agencies, and the preparation, if required, of environmental impact reports and negative declarations in connection with that evaluation; and

WHEREAS, the Big Bear Area Regional Wastewater Agency ("Agency") must revise its local guidelines for implementing CEQA to make them consistent with the current provisions and interpretations of CEQA;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Big Bear Area Regional Wastewater Agency hereby resolves as follows:

SECTION 1. The Agency adopts "Local Guidelines for Implementing the California Environmental Quality Act (2001 Revision)," a copy of which is on file at the offices of the Agency and is available for inspection by the public.

SECTION 2. All prior actions of the Agency enacting earlier guidelines are hereby repealed.
